Support provided depends on the assessed need and the funding arrangement for each person. Services range from allied health weekly sessions to intensive 24/7 support.


Attendant Care Services and Support Worker

Attendant care services available include support with:

- Personal care
- Meal preparation, cooking eating and drinking
- shopping
- Making and attending appointments
- Laundry, gardening and other household tasks
- Taking prescribed medications
- Recreation, leisure and community access
- Liasing with other support services and community networks
- Maintaining friendships and social networks
- Accessing cultural and spiritual activities

Recreation, Leisure and Community Access

Support services are available to assist in the planning and development of recreation and leisure programs to support skills development to facilitate community inclusion and to assist in linking the person to peer support and social networks.

Nursing Care and Intensive daily supports

Nursing Service is available seven days a week and supports people who may need nursing care or health monitoring. Skilled staff are available to support people who require :

- Complex Bowel Care
- Enteral (Naso-Gastric Tube –Feeding and Management
- Urinary Catheter Management
- Subcutaneous Injections
- Complex Wound Management



ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

A range of accommodation options are available.

Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA)

SDA: is housing that has been specially designed or modified to suit the needs of people with physical support needs, including 'high support needs'. If you are eligible, the NDIS funds the cost of your housing through SDA payments.

We have Platinum level houses available. Please contact to check availability.

Shared Supported Accommodation (SIL)

Shared accommodation offers the opportunity for residents to live with other people and have the support they require whilst also developing their independence. All our houses are single storey, close to amenities and designed for easy access. Participants pay the rent for these places.

Respite/short-term and medium term stays are available.
